School Based Traineeships and School Based Apprenticeships (SBATs) require students to undertake a minimum of 100 days (and up to 180 days) paid work whilst completing the Higher School Certificate. SBATs usually commence in Year 11 and are to be completed by December 31 of the HSC year.

It is essential that students speak to their Careers Adviser about their subject choices for Year 11 and 12 before submitting an expression of interest. Careers Advisers will help students apply for the appropriate course at school or TAFE and will reinforce the commitment required to undertake an SBT or SBA as part of the Higher School Certificate.

Information Sessions

Students who complete an Expression of Interest should attend an information session you're your interested caregivers. See your Careers Advisor for more information. The session will provide information about how an SBAT works as part of the HSC, work requirements, how to apply for positions and the role of group training companies. This session will also highlight the differences between a School Based Traineeship and School Based Apprenticeship.

Please be advised that SBAT positions are highly competitive. Employers select the candidate who will be offered an SBAT based on your application, interview and workplace trial.

Application Process and Work Trials

Positions will be advertised directly to students who have submitted an EOI. Your Careers Advisers will receive an email notifying them that the students have been contacted and outlining ways in which they can support them during the application process.

Employers select their staff through a variety of methods. These include written or online applications, group and individual interviews and assessment testing. Work trials are not compulsory, although some employers may ask students to undertake a work trial to assess their suitability for the industry and their business or if they are having difficulty trying to choose between applicants. Your school will organise the work experience paperwork if a work trial is required.

Sign Up and Training Contract

Students who are successful in gaining an SBAT will be required to sign a training contract for the duration of the SBAT. Further details will be provided at the information sessions.
